THE OPENING OF THE 150TH JUBILEE AT LOURDES The Vatican Proclaims An Indulgence During the Jubilee Year



Opening the Jubilee Year at St. Michael's Gate

and Most Revered Perrier unlocked Saint Michael's Gate on December 8, 2007 to officially open the yearlong Jubilee honoring the 150th anniversary of the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Bernadette Soubirous. Thousands of pilgrims and priests from around the world arrived

This will be a year of grace and of indulgences! To honor the anniversary, the Vatican announced that the Holy Father proclaimed a plenary indulgence for the faithful on pilgrimage to Lourdes, with the normal Sacramental conditions and the inclusion of prayerfully

following the Jubilee Path. The 150th Jubilee will close on December 8, 2008.

Over 75,000 pilgrims were present on the 150th anniversary and feast day of Our Lady of Lourdes, February 11, including over 1,000 priests. The processions and celebration were magnificent!

To honor the Jubilee, Bishop Perrier will visit the United States, his only scheduled visit to share the Message of Lourdes in 2008. Also announced is the intended visit of Pope Benedict XVI to Lourdes this fall.

UNITALSI Vice President-Physician Visits Coast to Coast with Lourdes Volunteers

Dr. Marco Tampellini, a Turin University Hospital oncology practitioner, staff professor of medicine and a UNITALSI vice-president, visited both California and New York to share his vast expertise in the care and transport of the terminally ill and handicapped to Lourdes.

UNITALSI was founded in 1903 to accompany both ill and disabled pilgrims to the Grotto and is the largest organization in Italy to bring both sick and handicapped pilgrims to Lourdes. Each year 100,000 pilgrims are welcomed at their 350 bed facility, Salus Infirmorum, an accueil designed to meet the special needs of sick and handicapped pilgrims.

Thousands of volunteers and medical professionals accompany and tenderly care for all pilgrims throughout their 2-3 day journey by train and their 5 day stay in Lourdes.

Dr. Marco made several visits to share experiences. Meeting with the Order of Malta Western and Federal Associations, our NY office team and Medical Director, Dr. Michael Martinelli, to help pilgrimages and offer expert help and assistance.

Andrea provided the real example to our Medical Advisory Board for special needs possibilities. As a result, Andrea was appointed the first non-medical Honorary Board Member. Andrea was named for her witness to the possibilities for critically ill, terminally ill and profoundly handicapped to make pilgrimage to Lourdes with prudent planning and expert medical preparation.

At Andrea's request, a fund was created to assist special needs pilgrims to Lourdes. In her memory, individuals and families will be able to fulfill her wish and make pilgrimage to Lourdes.

Travel Tips: Tags and Wallets

- → Personalized Luggage Tags are provided to each traveler for identification of all baggage and easier assistance to safely claim luggage upon arrival.
- → Wheelchair Tags are provided for each piece and part of the chair that may be dismantled during transfer and baggage claim.
- → Medical Equipment Tags are provided for each

piece of equipment carried on board or checked in.

- → Neck wallets are now provided to each traveler for easy access and safe keeping of airline tickets and passport during travel.
- → Printed ticket jackets with our travel itinerary and airline information are provided to each traveler in their neck wallet for easy reference during travel.

Pilgrimage Helpers: Medical and Lay Volunteers

Each pilgrimage, we travel to Lourdes as a *family*. Sometimes our family has special needs and capable family members lovingly meet all the care needs throughout travel and our pilgrimage time in Lourdes.

Companions are often family members or friends who join pilgrims to share the pilgrimage experience. Volunteer companions are sometimes recruited to be the family or friend to a special needs pilgrim to offer wheelchair or dining assistance, but more often,
