HOLY FATHER 150TH JUBILEE GROTTO VISIT

Pope Benedict XVI made his Jubilee Pilgrimage to Lourdes September 13, 14 and 15. An exuberant crowd estimated at 190,000 pilgrims awaited the arrival of the Pontiff in Lourdes.

Two hundred and fifty Bishops, Archbishops and Cardinals with 920 priests from around the world traveled from Asia, Africa, Europe and both North and South America to join the Holy Father in prayer at the Grotto and to make the Jubilee Way in honor of the 150th anniversary of the eighteen apparitions.

Throughout his three day visit, the Holy Father spoke of the Message of Lourdes and its relevance to us today. Recalling the gracious invitation of the Immaculate Conception to

International Military Pilgrimage

The 50th International Military Pilgrimage and our inaugural Pilgrimage for Wounded, Veterans and Retired US Military with Families coincided with the 150th Jubilee anniversary at Lourdes. Over 20,000 military men and women from over thirty countries joined together in prayer for peace and healing in thanksgiving for the end of WWII.

Archbishop Broglio was present in Lourdes with US Military Communities of Europe taking time to meet with our pilgrims and our pilgrimage leaders including Air Force Major Christine Corbett-Cole and Army veterans returning from deployment, Iraqi Veteran Reverend Lt. Colonel Neal Buckon and Afghani Veteran medic Major Brian Weber.
