Our historic Guadalupe House overlooks the old rectory doorway where St. Bernadette Soubirous on March 25, 1848, told Abbé Peyramale the name of the lady appearing to her in the Grotto: "I am the Immaculate Conception."



This spacious 5,000 square foot residence is well suited to meet the needs of the first American Lourdes Hospitality. Our private home is ideally located between the Grotto, the train station and town-center market.

Guadalupe House will be the private home to North American Lourdes Volunteers and guests.
